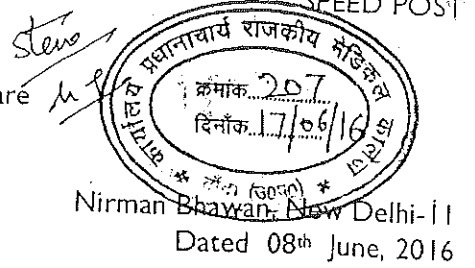



Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter dated 07.06.2016 accepting the conditions contained in Ministry's letter dated 30.05.2016, furnishing an undertaking and to convey the formal permission of the Central Government to Govt. of Uttar Pradesh for establishment of new medical college at Banda in the name of **GOVERNMENT ALLOPATHIC MEDICAL COLLEGE, BANDA** with intake of 100 MBBS students from the academic year 2016-17 under Section 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956.

2. This permission of the Central Government is accorded initially for a period of one year and will be renewed on yearly basis subject to the verification of the achievement of annual targets as indicated in your scheme. This process of renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed and a formal recognition of Medical College is granted.
3. The Government Medical Colleges (except those located in J&K, Andhra Pradesh & Telangana States) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for all India quota.
4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action under IMC Act, 1956 & Regulations made thereunder will be initiated.
5. Discrepancies, if any, may be brought to the Notice of MCI and Central/State Government.

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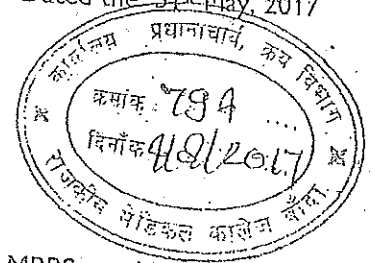



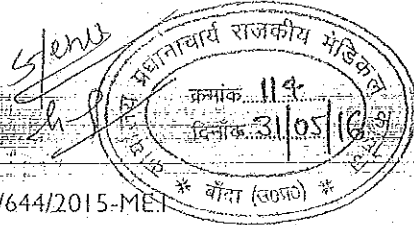

I am directed to refer to your proposal on the subject mentioned above seeking permission of the Central Government for establishment of new medical college at Banda, Uttar Pradesh by Government of Uttar Pradesh in the name of **Allopathic Medical College, Banda** under Section 10(A) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

2. After careful consideration of the scheme and taking into consideration the recommendations of Medical Council of India in this regard, this Ministry has come to a conclusion that a letter may be issued for obtaining certain essential documents in connection with issuance of Letter of Permission (LoP) for establishment of new medical college at Banda, Uttar Pradesh with intake of 100 students in MBBS course from the academic session 2016-17 under Section 10 (A) of IMC Act.

 - (ii) No student should be admitted in the above course till the formal permission of the Central Govt. is granted.
4. Action to grant formal permission of the Central Govt. for Establishment of New Medical College at Banda, Uttar Pradesh will be initiated on receipt of a compliance report fulfilling the conditions enumerated in paragraph 3 above. The acceptance letter/undertaking may be sent immediately to enable the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for the year 2016-17.
