01.	Department-wise review of deficiencies pointed out during MCI inspection and preparation for compliance inspection.	On 16 <sup>th</sup> March, 2020 MCI surprisingly inspected the institution for compliance verification and found the almost all deficiencies rectified except the shortage of faculty and unavailability of canteen. Committee is requested to expedite establishment of canteen in the campus and Hospital.
02.	How to increase IPD and indoor facilities in the Hospital ?	At the time of compliance inspection satisfactory bed occupancy i.e. 76% reported. Principal as well as members of the council appreciated the efforts of clinical consultants and suggested to further improvements.
03.	To discuss the issues regarding Examinations (Theory & Practical) duty/Practicals).	Instructions regarding invigilation duty in the theory examinations issued. In the Council's meeting issue of unavailability of Examiners for practical examination in some departments were also discussed and suggested to submit the list of easily available examiners to put up in meeting of Board of Studies of University.
04.	Review of proposals and their Gap analysis for applications of starting Post-graduate courses in pre and paraclinical departments.	Essentiality certificate for starting post-graduate courses in Anatomy, Physiology, Community Medicine and Forensic Medicine departments issued from Department of Medical Education, Govt. of U.P. and application for consent of affiliation submitted to King George's Medical University. Council Members suggested that HOD of concerned department practically take lead in starting Post-graduate courses in their departments.
05.	New facilities added at GAMC & their implementation.	Isolation ward for the patients infected with Corona virus established. Formalities for the establishment of Allahabad Bank's branch in the campus were almost completed from the institution end.
06.	Any other agenda suggested by Members with permission of the chair. • Emerging threats of Corona Virus • Aysman Bharat Yojana, implementation problems/challenges	Council's members suggested to organize CME regarding awareness of Corona virus infection. Also decided to organize awareness programmes like poster presentation, quiz and awareness through banners with the involvement of the students. Dr Sunil Kaushal, Associate Professor, Community Medicine Department discussed the challenges of implementation of Aysman Bharat Yojana and informed to plan the meeting in the last week of March month regarding issues.
